The Town of Clayton Fire District Board of Fire Commissioners is seeking letters of interest from interested residents in filling a recently vacated seat for the remainder of the 2022 fiscal year. A fire district is an independent corporate entity governed by a board of fire commissioners. Fire commissioners are elected by the qualified voters of the fire district at an annual election held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of December each year. The term of office for an elected fire commissioner is five years.

When a vacancy occurs, the board of fire commissioners may appoint an individual to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the year, at which time the individual may run for election to complete the term of that vacancy.

Meetings are held at 7:00 PM on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month alternating between Clayton Meeting Room and Depauville Social Hall and are open to the public.
