

**RESOLUTION 2022-2**  
**OF**  
**THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS**  
**OF**  
**THE TOWN OF CLAYTON FIRE DISTRICT**

Upon motion duly made by Commissioner Jacob Angus, seconded by Commissioner Scott Johnson and carried at a meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Town of Clayton Fire District (the "Fire District") held on May 11, 2022, at which a quorum of the members was present, the following resolutions were adopted by a majority vote of the members:

**WHEREAS**, the Fire District has made a determination that it is in the public interest for the district to purchase a Custom Chassis 1500 GPM pumper; and

**WHEREAS**, the district has determined that it is in the public interest of the people to purchase such custom chassis pumper, pursuant to and consistent with the provisions of New York General Municipal Law Section 103, Subdivision 16, known as the "Piggybacking" Law, which is an exception to the competitive bidding process; and

**WHEREAS**, the district has made a determination that the requirements of the Piggybacking Law have been met, in that the Sourcewell is a local governmental agency which has made available for use by other governmental entities a contract for the purchase of such custom chassis pumper which contract has been let in a manner which constitutes competitive bidding consistent with New York State Law; and

**WHEREAS**, to further such purchase, it is necessary for the District to enter into an Interlocal Contract for Cooperative Purchasing with Sourcewell to assist in the procurement of such custom chassis pumper; and

**WHEREAS**, it is further necessary for the District to place a deposit for the purchase of such vehicle, and, subject to permissive referendum; it is hereby:

**RESOLVED**, that the Fire District purchase a custom chassis pumper for a sum not to exceed \$675,000.00; and it is further

**RESOLVED**, that the Fire District use, subject to permissive referendum as required by the New York State Local Finance Law the sum of \$ 675,000.00 from its Type Reserve Fund for the down payment for the said vehicle; and it is further

**RESOLVED**, that the Fire District is authorized to enter into a contract with Sourcewell to facilitate the purchase of the said custom chassis pumper.
